

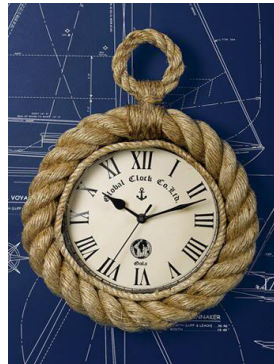

From the Helm

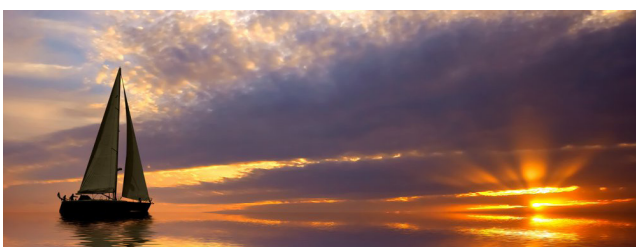
